

Shepparton RSL Sub Branch HUMP DAY DOLLARS Terms & Conditions

Each Wednesday night (commencing 1/10/25), the Shepparton RSL Sub-Branch hosts Hump Day Dollars which will have a rolling jackpot of \$250 cash as a prize each week.

How it works:

With every MAIN (and Senior's) meal purchased, between 6pm and 8pm, both members and non-members will receive a ticket for a complimentary pot pf tap beer, glass of house wine or pot of soft drink. They will receive these tickets when ordering from the main register in the bistro.

The complimentary drink must be redeemed in the bistro or main bar on the same evening.

When redeeming the drink, patron needs to write their full name and phone number on the back of the ticket and hand it to the staff member serving them. They will receive their drink and the ticket will go in the barrel or entry boxes to be included in the draw to win the cash prize.

Shepparton RSL financial members will also receive an entry each time they swipe their members card in the bar or bistro between 6pm and 8pm. Those entries will also need to be placed in the entry barrel or boxes to be included in the draw.

At 8pm we will draw the cash prize and the patron must be present to win (having 2 minutes to collect the prize). The prize money will start at \$250 and if no winner found, will jackpot by \$250 to the following week. There is no limit to how high the jackpot could go!

Whenever a cash prize is claimed, no further draws will take place for that evening and the cash prize resets to \$250 for the following week.

Only the person who's name is drawn can claim the cash prize. No spouse, friend or relative can claim the prize on their behalf. The winner must be able to present photo ID or their current RSL Victoria Membership Card along with identification if requested. If they do not meet this criteria, they will not be able to claim the prize.

Only people 18+ years of age can take part in this promotion.

Shepparton RSL Sub Branch staff members and current Committee Members are not eligible to win.

The decision of the Shepparton RSL Sub Branch is final in any disputes that may arise.
